#### Materials

Please bring with you:

Watercolour paper or pad

Board minimum size 16" x 12" (not needed if you bring a pad of paper)

Brushes

Container for water

Watercolour paints {tubes or pans}

Pallet for mixing (small plastic one ideal)

Pencils and Soft eraser
